

GUIDELINES FOR ESA INTERNATIONAL ARIZONA COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

- STUDENT MUST HAVE BEEN AN ARIZONA RESIDENT FOR AT LEAST TWO (2) YEARS.
- Award is restricted to students who plan to enroll as a full-time student (12 hours or more per semester) in any approved curriculum of an Arizona University, college, or community college of their choice.
- This is a one-year scholarship. Students must re-apply each year.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (one academic, one non-academic) and a copy of the student's transcript must accompany applications.
- An essay to include extracurricular activities and financial need in detail.
- Selection of recipient will be based on: **scholarship, character, financial need, leadership and ability.**
- This scholarship shall be awarded in addition to any other grants or scholarships.
- The award may be used toward tuition, housing, fees, books, supplies, or other college living expenses.
- \$500.00 shall be deposited directly to the school of the recipient's choice to be disbursed to the student at registration of that semester.
- The student must send a transcript to the Scholarship Chairman prior to the beginning of the second semester to receive the second payment of their awarded scholarship.
- The award shall be cancelled if:
 - The student does not maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
 - The student is not a full-time student (12 hours per semester or more), or
 - The student's conduct is such as to be a discredit to the school.

DEADLINE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS IS FEBRUARY 28, 2010.
